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14. What is the gift of God?

15.. Explain in your own words how Timothy received the gift of God?

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16. When the Gentile Cornelius and his family heard the gospel from Peter, they believed in Jesus - what happened next? Why was is this such an important event?

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17. What is the 'mystery', which was hidden from the beginning of the ages in God?
